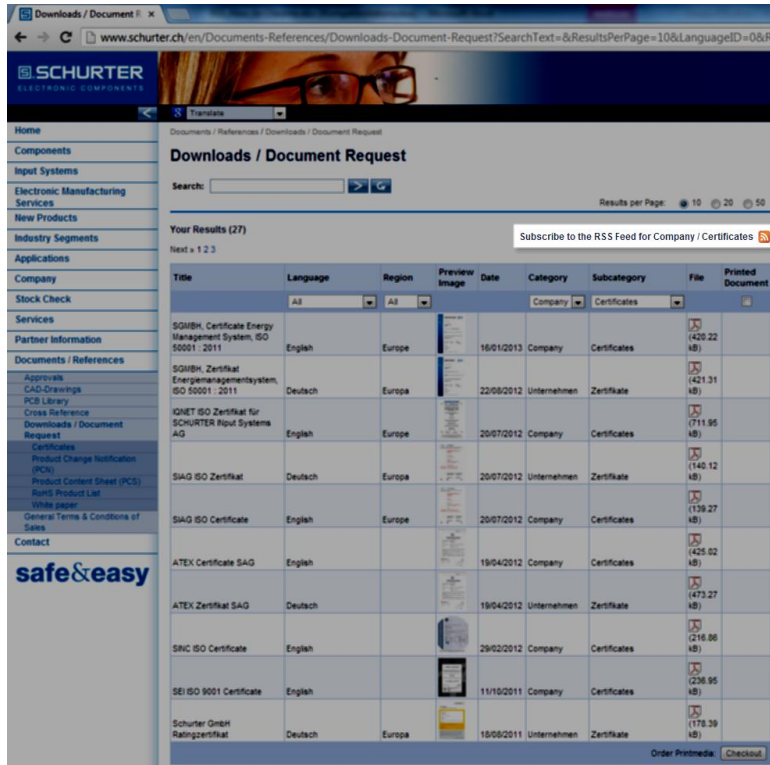


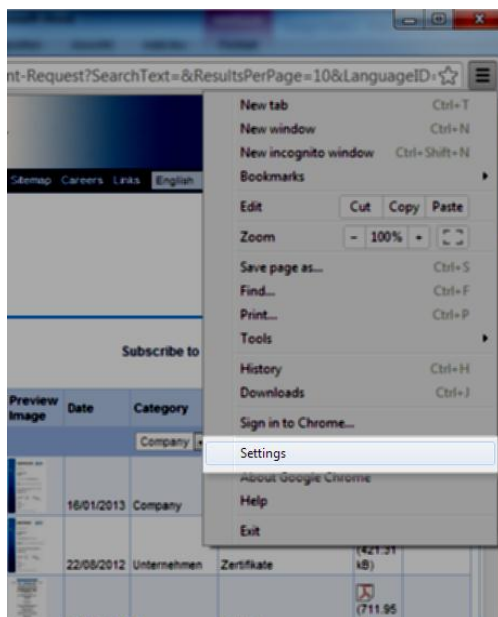
## 1 Adding an RSS Feed to Chrome (with an app)

In Chrome navigate to the desired RSS feed link and click on it.



In order to use RSS feeds with Google Chrome, a suitable app needs to be installed. Both Google Reader and Feedly are recommended.

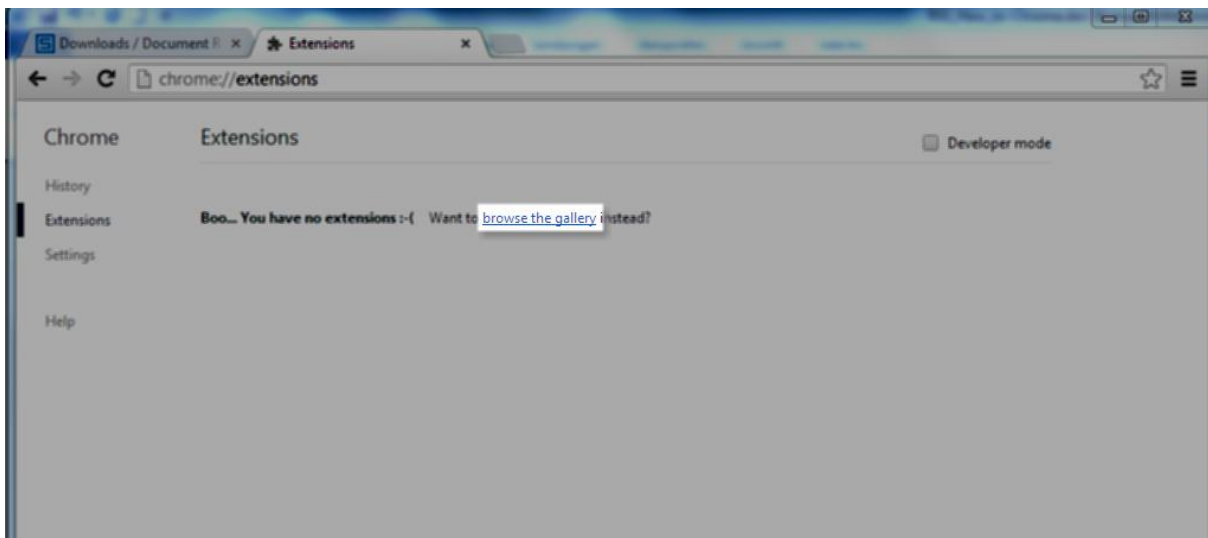
Click on settings,



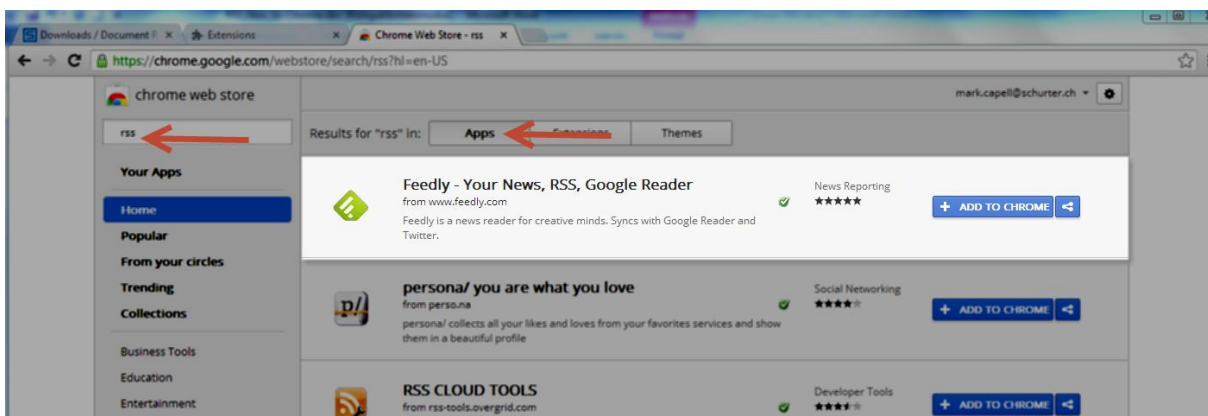

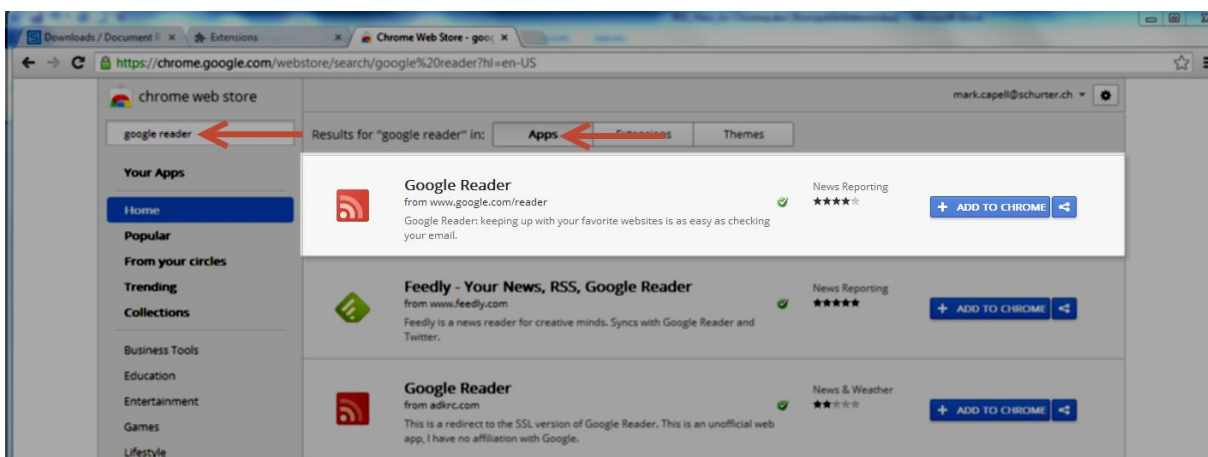
Then click on extensions and go to the gallery



If you search for RSS and search within Apps, you have a selection of RSS Readers. Feedly is recommended. Click on “Add” to install.

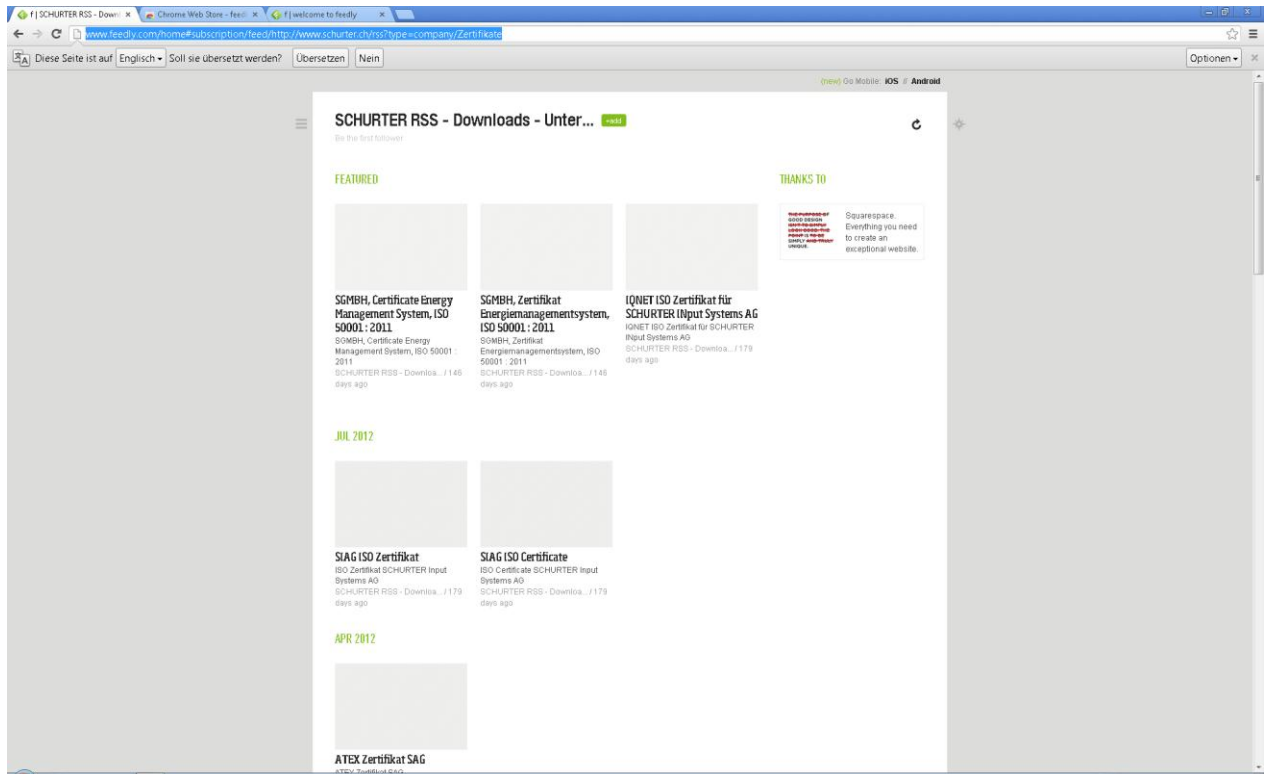


A popular alternative is “Google Reader”.
